

SCENARIO TWO

Listen to the short story and then discuss the questions below.

Two friends, Lisa and Mitchell, are walking home from school. As they are walking through the neighborhood to their homes, they see another student ahead of them walking towards them. This student just happens to be a person of color. Lisa, seeing the other student, turns to Mitchell and tells him that she's uncomfortable and wants to cross to the other side of the street. Mitchell, now feeling the pressure from his friend, decides to follow Lisa to the other side of the street.

- > What was Lisa uncomfortable with and why?
- > How should Mitchell have responded to Lisa?
- > How do you think the other student felt when they crossed the street?
- > What are some things Lisa can do to help her no longer feel uncomfortable in these types of situations?
